INTRODUCTION

Due to the close-knit nature of our society, which is keen on presenting its members in the best possible way, many choose to conceal certain illnesses affecting their relatives, especially when these illnesses impact their behavior or judgment. Therefore, the idea of establishing the Saudi Alzheimer's Disease Association (SADA) emerged to break the barrier of silence and embarrassment, shedding light on the aspects surrounding the disease to raise public awareness in a way that serves both patients and their families. SADA also aims to engage decision-makers in understanding the various dimensions of the disease, its impact, and treatment costs, ultimately providing the necessary care and attention for both patients and those concerned with their well-being.

Hence, SADA was founded in 1430H (2009 CE).

Why was the Saudi Alzheimer's Disease Association established?

The idea to establish SADA was born from a group of devoted women whose parents had been affected by Alzheimer's disease. Their journey began with a search for others who shared their concern and passion for the cause. United by a common purpose, forty-five dedicated sons and daughters of this nation came together to take the initiative. Their collective efforts led to the official approval by the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Development, marking the formal establishment of the Saudi Alzheimer's Disease Association.




Our Goals







KEY MILESTONES & ACHIEVEMENTS

First: Institutional Establishment & Empowerment

Saudi Alzheimer's Disease Association was Founded in 2009 through a pioneering community initiative, with official support from the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Development.

Establishment of a comprehensive organizational and governance structure, including a Board of Directors and Advisory Board comprising distinguished experts.

Development of institutional strategy and operational model aligned with non-profit sector transformation.

Second: Scientific & Medical Leadership

Establishment of the National Alzheimer's Registry and a national database in collaboration with King Faisal Specialist Hospital (2011).

Localization of internationally accredited diagnostic and assessment tools while preserving intellectual property rights

Contribution to establishing specialized Alzheimer's clinics in major hospitals across the Kingdom.

Advocacy for the inclusion of Alzheimer's patients in health insurance coverage.

Third: Community Awareness & Education

Launching and implementing national awareness campaigns on Alzheimer's disease across various regions of the Kingdom

Implementing hundreds of training sessions, workshops, and awareness activities aimed at empowering caregivers and improving community understanding of Alzheimer's disease

Producing awareness films and media messages broadcast locally and regionally, in addition to specialized publications and educational materials

Launching an interactive website, social media platforms, and a specialized electronic store to support awareness and outreach efforts

Representing the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia regionally and internationally in Alzheimer's and dementia-related issues.

This pathway provides direct support to patients and their families, particularly the most vulnerable groups, and operates under the supervision of the Social Support Committee.

The project offers comprehensive support services for individuals living with Alzheimer's disease across all stages, early, moderate, and advanced. Its primary goal is to ensure the comfort and dignity of patients while easing the physical and emotional burden on their caregivers and families. As part of this initiative, the project provides essential medical equipment, including specialized Alzheimer's

A supportive medical device equipped with a soft, secure safety harness, specifically designed to assist patients who are unable to move independently from their beds. The initiative reflects the Association's deep commitment to delivering holistic services to families affected by Alzheimer's and to closely monitoring and supporting the cases it sponsors through all available channels

One of the key devices provided is the electric medical bed, designated for Alzheimer's patients who are bedridden and require enhanced

Taryaq Pathway

(Health Support)

This pathway delivers comprehensive healthcare support for Alzheimer's patients and their families, focusing on education, empowerment, and quality of life improvement.

It operates under the direct supervision of the Scientific Committee.

Taryaq Pathway

A request to arrange home visits by a senior medical consultant for critical cases. The service would be offered at a cost ranging from 1,500 to 2,000 SAR for financially capable families, and free of charge for individuals registered under the social security system.



26 Patient's

The Association organizes home visits for Alzheimer's patients conducted by specialized geriatric medicine physicians, in collaboration with the Ministry of Health's Homecare Program. These visits aim to diagnose and manage Alzheimer's cases in accordance with the Ministry's approved standards and medical protocols



50 Patient's

The association organizes a specialized free clinic in collaboration with the Ministry of Health, under a signed agreement that meets all medical requirements. In this clinic, specialists in Alzheimer's disease (including neurologists, internists, family medicine, and geriatric physicians) diagnose and treat various stages of Alzheimer's disease, in accordance with the standards and regulations set by the Ministry of Health.

Remote diagnosis of Alzheimer's disease with specialists in the field (geriatricians and neurologists), issuance of an electronic prescription for medication, and conducting laboratory tests and imaging for patients at their homes.





The association, under the signed agreement with the Ministry of Health, organizes a project for diagnostic clinics and the provision of services through specialized applications. Services are delivered by specialists in the field of Alzheimer's disease (geriatricians, internists, neurologists) as well as radiology and laboratory technicians, with patient follow-up conducted remotely.

A project that includes providing, delivering, and dispensing medications for Alzheimer's patients based on an electronic prescription, as these medications are not available in hospitals or government sectors.

An electronic training program available to caregivers, covering multiple skills and mechanisms for managing behavioral disorders associated with Alzheimer's disease and its symptoms that are often difficult to control



A leading training program implemented across various regions of the Kingdom, aimed at training caregivers on how to manage Alzheimer's patients throughout all stages of the disease and understand behavioral and cognitive changes associated with disease progression



The Association established WhatsApp support groups for Alzheimer's caregivers, bringing together caregivers and Association staff to share daily experiences, challenges, and care practices. These groups aim to exchange expertise, promote correct caregiving behaviors, and provide continuous psychological and social support under the supervision of the social and health rehabilitation team 24/7



An intensive cognitive-behavioral guidance and rehabilitation program aimed at improving coping strategies and reducing psychological stress among family caregivers




THE INTEGRATIVE FRIENDSHIP PROJECT
